<p><b><u>Positive Play Programme</u></b>                      The Positive Play Programme is to raise the self-esteem of children and young people, helping them to access the curriculum and so achieve their potential</p>	<p>£2000</p>	<p>To allow young people a space to express and communicate feelings and difficulties in their lives, through a variety of media in constructive rather than aggressive ways and in a safe non-threatening environment.</p> <p>To help young people feel good about themselves, and raise self-esteem by providing activities that look at their strengths and by valuing what they do and making it special.</p> <p>To provide a non-authoritarian, supportive, reliable, safe, unconditional relationship within the school and other settings.</p> <p>To help young people acquire the complex range of life skills needed to achieve their full potential.</p>

<p><b>Academic Trips and Events</b> Day trips and residential trip will be paid for by the PP Grant.</p>	<p>36 pupils X £15.00 x3 times per year</p> <p>£1620.00</p> <p>£4000.00</p>	<p>All pupils will be able to attend educational trips paid for through pupil premium.</p> <p>Equality of education and opportunity for PP pupils, alongside non-PP pupils.</p>

<p><b>Pupil Progress Meetings</b></p> <p>Teachers and teaching assistants will meet with the headteacher and the assistant headteacher every half term to ensure that pupils are achieving their potential and that their needs are being catered for through a variety of different provision.</p> <p>Additionally the headteacher and assistant headteacher will meet six pupils from every class prior to the meeting taking place to ensure pupils get a chance to reflect and voice their thoughts and feelings on their provision and learning.</p>	<p>£3,400</p>	<p>All pupils make at least good progress but a large proportion make outstanding progress.</p>
