

Following our recent graded inspection on 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> November, I am very proud to be able to share the results of the Ofsted Inspection Report with you.

As you will see from the report, Ofsted have rated Fulfen Primary School as "OUSTANDING" in every area and for its overall effectiveness as a school. The evidence collected throughout the inspection has been rigorously quality assured over the past weeks and we are delighted with the outcome.

The findings of the inspection highlight many of the strengths of our school and the investment that is made in our pupils every day by all our staff:

"The school is a special place to be."

"Children in the early years get off to an exceptional start."

"Pupils feel safe because adults go 'above and beyond'... Care for pupils is exemplary and staff leave 'no stone unturned' to ensure that pupils do well in their learning. They know that happy children are more likely to thrive, and many do."

"There is an exceptional curriculum on offer."

"Pupils' learning is enhanced by the effective use of technology...staff often stretch pupils' learning beyond what was previously possible."

In addition to these quotes, the lead inspector spoke very highly of our school during the verbal feedback to the leadership team and governing body. He regularly used the words "*exceptional*" and "*rare*" throughout his evaluation of our school and used the following phrases as he concluded the inspection:
