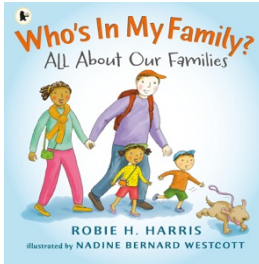




Reception Newsletter- 16.9.24
