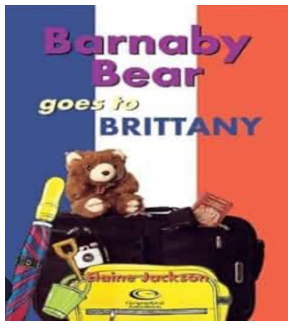




Reception Newsletter- 23.9.24
