PHONICS

We will learn to say, recognise and write:

/m/ as in mouse

/d/ as in dog

We will practise orally blending and segmenting words with these sounds:

m-a-n/m-o-p/S-a-m/m-a-d/d-i-p/s-a-d



MATHS

We will explore how numbers can be composed of 1s and begin to find different ways to make 3 and 4.

Vocabulary:

part, whole, subitise, altogether

WAYS TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME:

Encourage your child to practise writing their name and support them to form each letter accurately.

Support your child to accurately write the numbers 1-5 and count and match numbers and amounts accurately.

Complete the phonics sheets; practise writing the new graphemes and words.

Assist your child to copy/trace/write the sentences: It is a map. The man is mad.
