PHONICS

We will learn to say, recognise and write:

/g/ as in goat

/o/ as in octopus

We will practise orally blending and segmenting words with these sounds:

g-o-t/d-i-g/r-a-g/t-o-p/m-o-m/n-o-t



MATHS

We will be revisiting subitising and continue to develop the children's number sense of quantities up to 5.

Key Vocabulary:

same, different, amount,

arranged, describe, pattern

WAYS TO SUPPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME:

Support your child to recall what they have learnt about pumpkins.

Encourage and support your child to identify amounts (up to 6) without counting.

Practise writing numbers 1-5 accurately.

Complete the Phonics homework to support your child to write the letters accurately and practise their segmenting skills to sound out and write the letters in order to make a word.
